## **INDUSTRY NEWS**

Rush University Medical Center is planning to build a \$500 million outpatient center just east of its main hospital tower, according to *Crain's Chicago Business*. The nine-story, 620,000 square-foot is expected to be completed in 2020.

The McCormick Place Event Center, which broke ground last month is moving toward a projected two-year construction schedule. The facility will also be the new home of DePaul University's men's and women's basketball. McPier and DePaul split the cost of the building, although it will be owned and operated by the agency.
