

NAFC'S WAGE THEFT WEBINAR

The National Alliance for Fair Contracting, Inc. held a webinar yesterday to highlight the work of local, state and federal prosecutors who are working to end wage theft on public construction projects.

In addition, the webinar featured enforcement units that brought criminal charges against employers for: 1) independent contractor abuse (worker misclassification); 2) Falsifying certified payrolls on prevailing wage jobs; 3) Fringe benefit fund fraud; 4) Kickback schemes; 5) Payroll tax fraud; 6) Workers compensation insurance fraud and other crimes.
