The 50,000 square-foot center will be complete in July 2017; and will offer the latest in technology-related, green construction techniques, and traditional plumbing skills courses.

Senate President John Cullerton



said in his remarks (see photo at left) that the facility will continue the union's proud heritage of providing worldclass training,

and developing a highly-trained and skilled workforce.

He also praised the privatelyfunded, labor/management model for training workers whose skills are the envy of the nation. Their expertise creates taxpayer value by reducing injuries and completing the job safely, on time and on-budget.

CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY BRACES FOR IDOL POSTINGS/BUDGET NEWS

Construction Industry leaders are monitoring developments on two fronts as a June 30 deadline nears.

HB6585/SB3435 are the two bills that, if passed, provide a stop gap budget for the State of Illinois to continue its business, which includes the continuation of road projects that fall under IDOT's jurisdiction. If the stopgap budget is not passed, all IDOT contracts and IDOT-let local projects will be affected.

The other issue of equal importance involves the June 30 deadline for the IDOL to receive certified payroll data for public construction projects in Illinois.

In the past, the department gathered information directly from the local unions and used that data to determine the wage rate pursuant to the Prevailing Wage Act.

This year, IDOL is also surveying contractors who they have identified as having performed construction for government agencies in Illinois and they are requesting each such firm to fill out an electronic survey.

IDOL stated they will ascertain and post prevailing wage rates by the end of July. If the rates are lower than the current CBA rates, the potential for legal action exists. Stay tuned.
