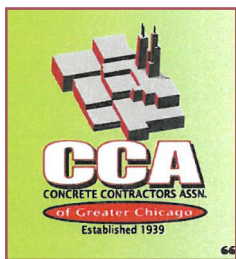
The event is Saturday, September 11th from 11 am - 3 pm at Kennedy-King College.

## 2021 CCAGC ANNUAL MEETING - THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14TH



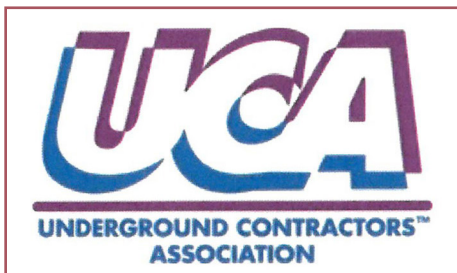
The Concrete Contractors Association of Greater Chicago will hold its Annual Meeting on Thursday, October 14.
